

#### COMING TO FULL COMMUNION

Many years back, I was working with a young woman who was in the RCIA and wished to become Catholic. She had been baptized as an infant in another Christian Church but was finding the Catholic Church fascinating. She had been with us for several months, asking many questions.

After she went through the Rite of Welcome, where a candidate is formally introduced to the community and asks for prayers and receives blessings, she clearly decided to become Catholic. After a few months she asked to talk to me about something that was weighing on her heart. She came to church semi-regularly, liking to attend our early Sunday Mass (6:30a.m.).

Her question for me was, "Am I supposed to be going to Mass every Sunday?" My answer, "Catholics are called to go to Mass every Sunday." She went on to explain that she noticed some of the same people were there every time she came and she knew many did not come all the time. I told her this was true. Not every Catholic comes every week to Mass.

But my question back to her, "you have publicly said you are seeking to come into full communion with the Catholic Church. And it sounds like your heart is leading you to embrace it fully. Do you want to be like others, or do you wish to live the faith life of the Church fully?" I think that was the question she already had her own answer to but needed my input to affirm it.

I don't think I ever saw her miss Mass again, even though it was no longer always at 6:30. And she loved talking about and sharing her faith, and continued as she moved and went into a new parish.

Her story leaves us with the question we all need to ask, whether priest, candidate, fully initiated Catholic, "am I living the faith as fully as I am called to by God?" What does it truly mean to live our faith and explore it regularly? Do people see us live our faith and know us as active Christians?
