Lots of years, lots of ministries. We salute him for his zeal in knowing so many, and serving so well. God Bless you Patrick as God continues the good work done in you and through you!

How do you follow that? Of course - ORDINATIONS! Our two Paulists to be ordained on May 18 served at Old St. Mary's – Dan Macalinao, csp [novice 2019] and Chris Lawton, csp [pastoral year 2019-2020]. 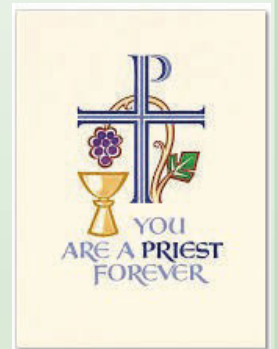
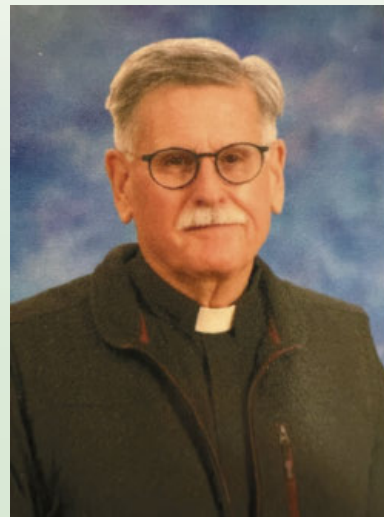

Through March our parish took in \$4826.17 less than needed to balance to budget. Weekly budget amount updated for internal adjustments made.

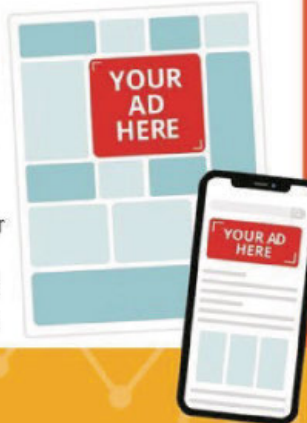
