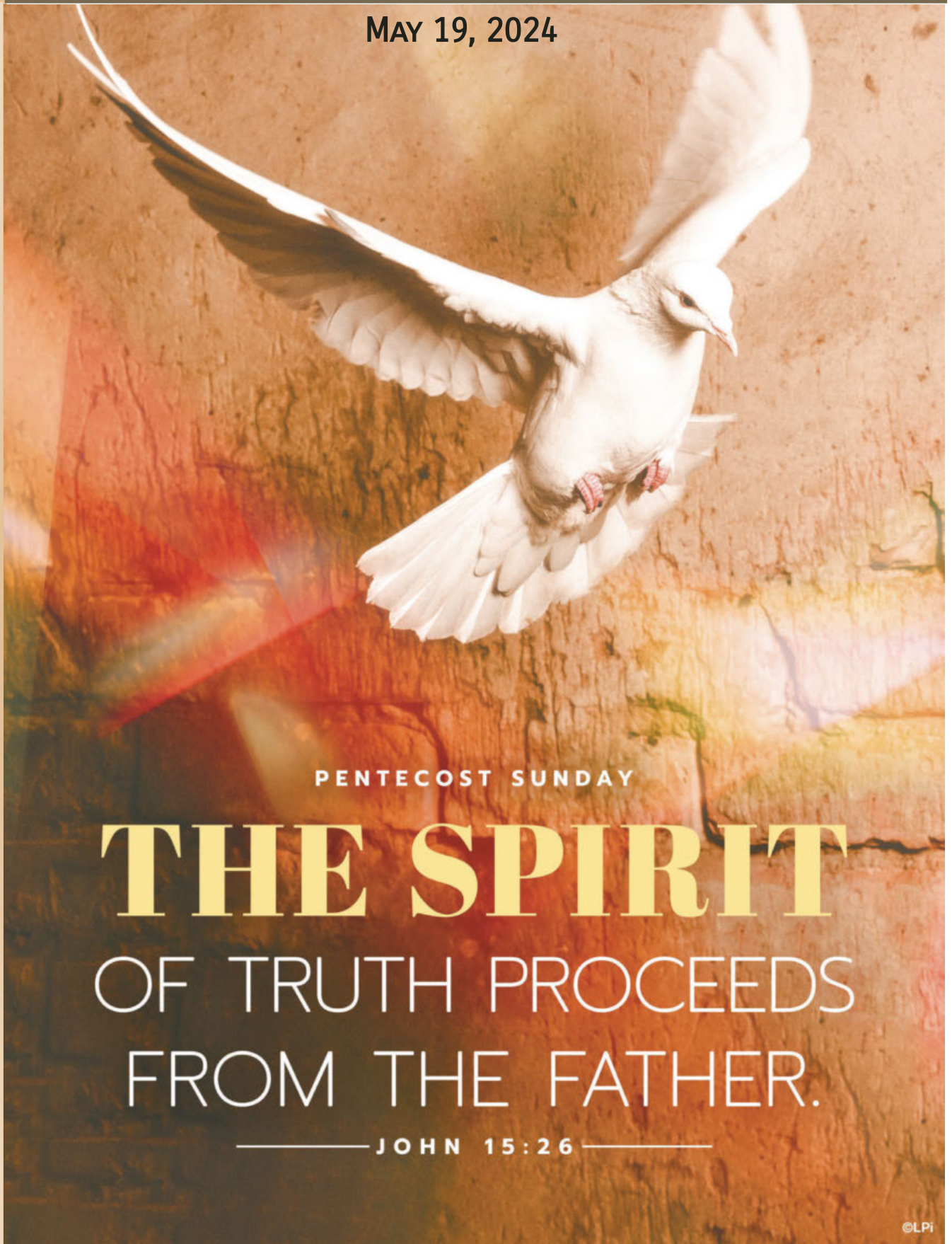

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### Pentecost & Times of Transition

If last week's celebration of the Ascension of the Lord was a time to pause, realize our individual calls and the charge that Jesus was placing on us, then this week's celebration of Pentecost is flat out forward we go.

Having said to you that I would be leaving as pastor was very difficult. At the same time, with Paulist Ordinations of Chris Lawton, CSP and Dan Macalinao, CSP, and with three new priests coming here, there is much Paulist excitement. That Chris and Dan are doing their first Masses at the Paulist Mother Church, St. Paul the Apostle in Manhattan, takes me back 24 years to my first Mass in the same place for the same feast. Something about Pentecost is both exciting and unsettling.

The only true way to deal with the power of Pentecost is to lean into the Holy Spirit. It is like learning to drive the bumper cars at the amusement park – you have to keep your foot to the floor (pedal to the metal all the way), and keep going. (It is not like driving a real car, although these days in Chicago there are people that drive like that.)

Having served you since 2018, I now begin a time of transition, figuring out exactly what the Lord wants me to do next. It also gives me time to reflect on what the last 6 years of ministry here have encompassed. I am most interested in how your journey to understand the Lord has been going. My hope would be that someday you could share with me your faith journey. I love hearing about how people connect with the Lord and what ways the Lord challenges and comforts.

With the world in the disarray it is in, I think my time of transition will be to grow in how the Lord calls me, specifically, to share the gospel more concretely, and to see through my own struggles and guided pathways, the Lord's direction for me.

But transitions, AKA changes, are always difficult. They shake us up. Our emotions are complicated by an array of reactions, sorrow, hopes, dreams, fears, faith, love, loss, and even more. Is it any wonder that the Holy Spirit is represented by a strong driving wind, or flames of fire?

The Holy Spirit is unbridled, wild and free. We generally prefer stable, solid, predictable and safe, and yet the Gospel tells us that is not the way of followers of Jesus. In the face of the presence of the Lord and our calls, if we accept the gift, then off we go with new words that will be understood by strangers and familiars alike and they will wonder where we get all of this. It is the Lord. And it takes us a while to get it as well..

Wishing you blessings on this Pentecost weekend! And the Lord's continued guidance on your journey, the journey of our newly ordained priests, and my journey too.

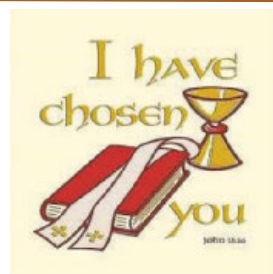

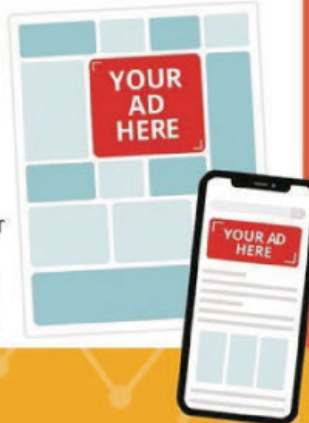

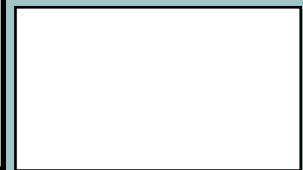
