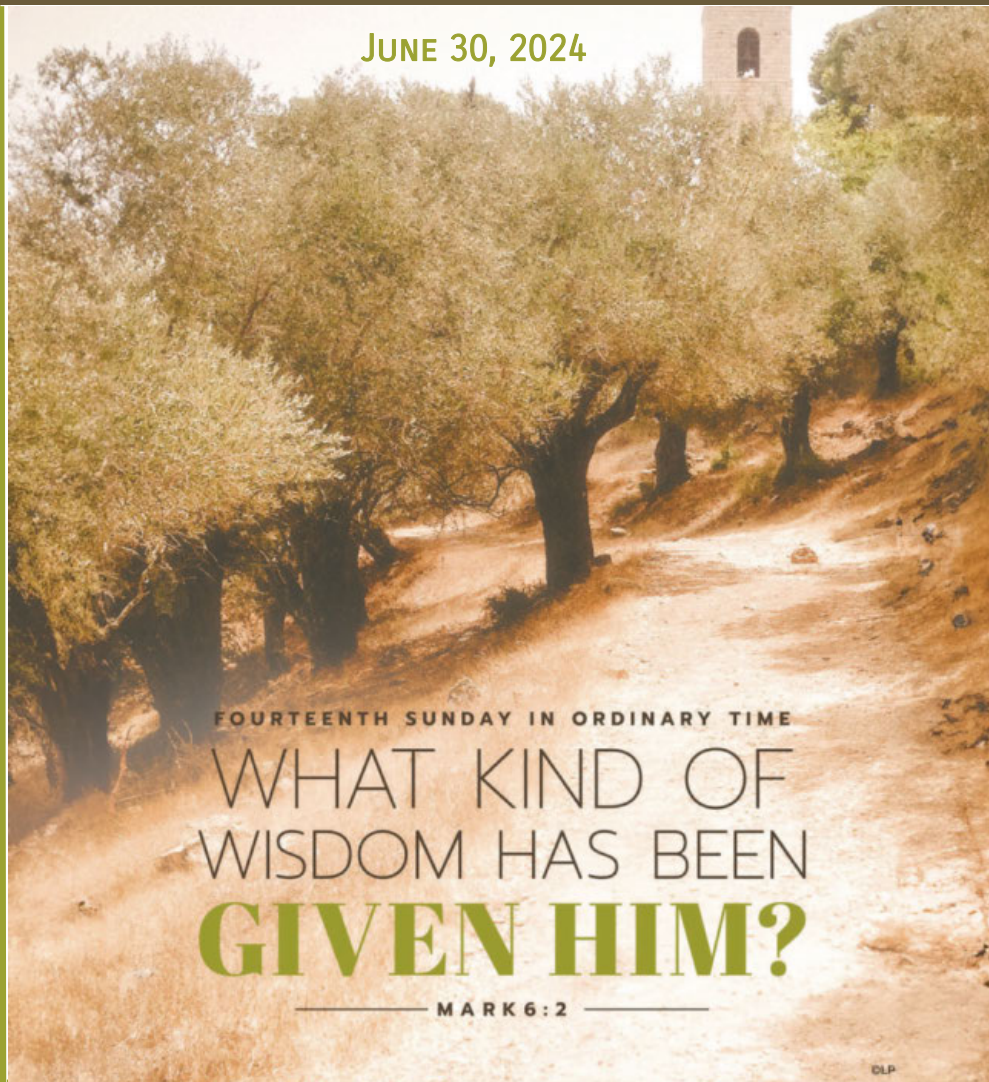

Message from our New Pastor

A Time of Transition, a Time of Excitement!

As of July 1, there are 3 new Paulist priests serving at Old St. Mary's! If you've belonged to OSM for at least 6 years, you may know 2 of us: our new associate pastor, Fr. Danilo Macalinao, served here in early 2019 when he was a novice. Fr. Robert Cary served here 2015-18, and he's back as a senior priest in residence. Dan was ordained a priest on May 18, and Bob celebrated his 40th anniversary on May 19. Congratulations to them both!

As for me, I'm extremely excited that the Paulists have asked me to be the next pastor of OSM! Most of you probably don't know me. I'm originally from Pittsburgh, PA, I have 2 degrees in optical engineering, and I've been ordained for 12 years. My previous priestly assignments were at St. John XXIII Parish at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, TN (2012-16); at St. Austin Parish across the street from the University of Texas in Austin, TX (2016-22); and at the Paulist Center in Boston, MA (2022-24). So many of you have already extended such a warm welcome to me, and I'm thrilled to be ministering in this vibrant, diverse neighborhood!

It is extremely rare for the Paulist Fathers to send a brand-new team of priests into a foundation all at once. Now that Fr. Brad and Fr. PJ have wrapped up their ministry at OSM, it is understandable for us to feel a bit nervous. In *Transitions: Making Sense of Life's Changes*, organizational consultant William Bridges pointed out that transitions start with an ending, end with a beginning, and have an in-between time of uncertainty. We will all naturally experience some uncertainty while Dan, Bob, and I settle in and get to know the rest of you!

A few things are already clear, however:

- Many people at OSM feel as if our liturgies have become a bit "tired." I think you'll find that Dan, Bob, and I will bring a new energy to Mass. Please pray about what gifts you can offer during the liturgies at OSM. I hope that we can triple the number of active lectors, sacristans, greeters, ushers, and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion on our rosters over the next few months.
- It's been a decade since OSM last articulated a clear mission statement. It will take a while for all of us to determine how best to proclaim the saving gospel of Jesus Christ in the local community, but that proclamation will likely include more outreach to our neighbors. It will also include a vision that better unifies all the families of Old St. Mary's School – the largest ministry of our parish – within the rest of the OSM community.
- We can find ways to direct the strengths of our diversity towards the cause of justice. I'm hoping we can be guided in part by my previous pastoral experiences. As a Paulist student, I served for 16 months in Maryland at one of the most multicultural parishes in the world. I've also been involved with innovative justice ministries in Massachusetts, Ohio, Tennessee, and Texas.

The work before us is significant, but I am fully confident that together we can achieve these goals! Here's what you can do to specifically support me as I settle in:

- Stay tuned for many opportunities to serve on advisory councils and committees, as well as in other ministries. Pope Francis' call for a more synodal Church invites everyone to be co-responsible for the leadership of the parish. First up: if you love to eat, if you consider yourself a wine connoisseur, if you love to make eye contact with strangers, and/or if you have a strong devotion to the Eucharist, prayerfully consider if the Holy Spirit is inviting you to serve as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion! Join us at 3 pm on Saturday, July 20, for training.

- Stay up-to-date with the weekly bulletin, the biweekly email newsletter, and the OSM App. Make sure we have your current email address on file!
- One of my main roles right now is to serve as the Listener-In-Chief. **After each of the 4 Masses on the weekend of July 27-28**, I'll stay as long as it takes for everyone to privately share with me what excites them, what frustrates them, and what gives them hope about OSM. (Please note that this is separate from the meet-and-greet receptions that we'll have for Dan, Bob and me after each of the Masses on the weekend of July 20-21) If you're not around on the weekend of July 27-28, please email me your excitements, frustrations, and hopes.

- I have spent shockingly little time in Chicago. (If you have a pastoral issue you'd like to discuss, I'd rather we talk about that in my office on another day of the week.)

Once again, on behalf of Dan, Bob, and me, we are absolutely delighted to be serving here!

Through May our parish took in \$30,215.70 less than needed to balance to budget.

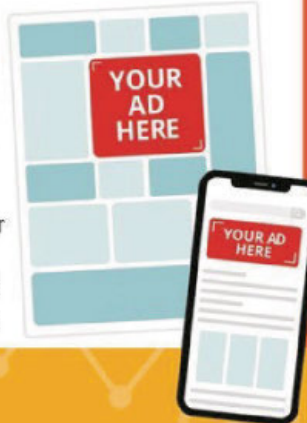
