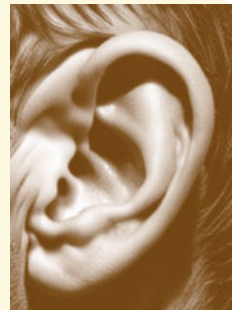

Don't be surprised if you soon get an email message or a text message claiming to be one of the priests at OSM, saying something along the lines of "Hello [Name], Let me know when you're available, I need your assistance with something."

**Do not reply to these messages unless it comes from an email address or cell phone number that you recognize.** Scammers often impersonate clergy, since most people trust religious leaders. OSM staff will almost always communicate with you through our [oldstmarys.com](http://oldstmarys.com) or [osmschool.com](http://osmschool.com) email addresses, and none of our priests use cell phone numbers with Illinois area codes.

## Pastoral Reflection

---

### BOXES

Since I was last on assignment at Old St. Mary's 2015-18 I lived in Grand Rapids for three years and then in Los Angeles for three years. Now the Paulist Fathers administration has asked me to return to Chicago as a senior Paulist in residence at Old St. Mary's. I am quite pleased to be here again even if I disappear south for a few weeks in the winter.

For the move from Los Angeles to Chicago I decided to drive, taking seven days to cross the country, visiting a few national parks in Utah and Colorado. What a vast and beautiful country we have. Moving requires sorting and packing. Paulist priests don't personally own sofas, TVs, or dining room sets so it is primarily books, papers --- 40 years of sermons and teaching notes --- clothes, and personal mementos. I shipped a few boxes, but the rest of my belongings needed to be packed into a rental car. So sorting and packing meant downsizing. I would sort through clothes and ask myself when was the last time I wore this shirt? If not in last 6-7 months then the item was donated to an agency that would give it to someone who needed to wear it now. I would pull books from the shelf and recall that it was a good read but it was not likely I would read it again. The Bible is an exception. Besides there is a rather large public library up the street. Files and papers were a bit harder to discard. My more recent work is saved electronically. But other materials are just paper evidence of past accomplishments. I can be proud of my work while accepting that I will not be called to do these tasks again.

I found the downsizing of "my stuff" to be a good model for what we all need to do as we go through life. A model applicable at any of the stages of life. There are chapters of our lives that have been good, even great experiences. We need to pack and hold onto to those memories and learning, but let go of the expectation we will repeat them. There have been hard times that have left scars for life, but we let go of the hurt, forgive and move on.

The rental car was only so big. It could only hold so many boxes. I couldn't bring everything from Los Angeles or Grand Rapids or Austin or Minneapolis. I needed to make room for new experiences, new learning, new people and renewal of acquaintances. So I am grateful for the exercise of moving and a new chapter here in Chicago.

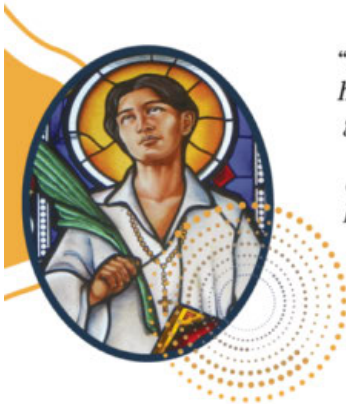

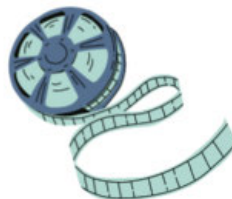
**Olive Wood Sale**

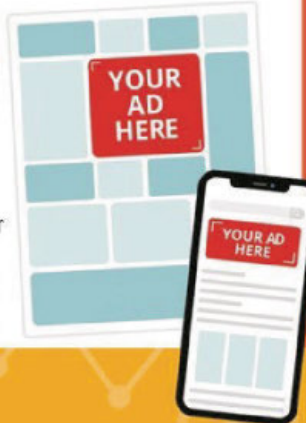
